2. Minutes of the meeting held on the 17th August 2017

The minutes of the meeting held on the 17th August 2017 were circulated, read, confirmed and signed as a true record.

3. Matters arising:- Road signs

The response from the County Councils Highways Dept was read out as our request for moving the 30mph signs near the Play Area to a distance of 150m down Mountstral Lane, was dismissed as not being practical or effective in slowing traffic and un-enforceable by the Police. Also to move the village sign, the cost of which would have to be borne by the PC but only after seeking and being approved for by the Highways and Planning departments. Annabel said she would take the matter up with Highways and report back.

Footpaths

Whilst it was generally known that there was no budget available from the County for repairs to the bridge on the footpath to Lovesome Hill, Annabel had received word on the day of our meeting that there had been sufficient funds made specially available to effect the repairs as soon as possible. This work would mean that the footpath should be useable by the spring walkers on the Coast to Coast route.

4. Children's Play Area:- Work had at last commenced on the installation of the concrete bases for the new seats and the box for play equipment. After consultation from Streetscape with the Chairman it was proposed at the meeting that rather than cause further delays and bad feeling, that the offer of a 50% reduction on the cost of a wooden ramp be accepted and commissioned.

5. Approval of various bills to be paid, i.e. Refund the 106 money to HDC for them to reissue to the Village Hall Committee for the purchase of the land.

6. Planning Applications:- No new applications received

7. Police Report:- None received and Alastair reported minor activity in the area during the month.

8. Any other business:- The Village Hall Committee had asked whether a new gate could be put in to allow access from the play park to the newly acquired field and of sufficient size to allow the grass cutters movement from one area to the other.
