## 2. Minutes of the meeting held on the 21st September 2017

The minutes of the meeting held on the 21st September were circulated, read, confirmed and signed as a true record.

**3. Matters arising:-** Road signs:-

Following the Councils request for warning signs to motorists for children being around the vicinity of the Play area, NYCC have agreed to erect 2 signs and have requested approval of the location.

There is still a rejection to moving the 30mph signs on Mountsrall lane further south by NYCC, further thoughts on this required.

Footpaths:-

Although the footpath to Lovesome Hill remains closed awaiting bridge repairs, there is now funding available and it is hoped work will be completed before the walking season starts next year.

### Precept:-

After discussion it was agreed to keep the council tax precept for 2018/9 at the same level as it is currently.

**4. Children's Play Area:-** Due to the problems for children getting onto the zip wire, Streetscape have now been instructed to proceed with the building of the wooden ramp as soon as possible.

The new seats have been installed and secured to the concrete pads together with a box to hold play equipment. With the purchase of the events field by the Village Hall committee, a gate has been installed from the Play Park to allow access for people and mowing equipment to and from the field. It is hoped in time to move the football goal posts into the field and allow the purchase of additional play equipment particularly for the older children in the Play area.

There had been a complaint received re youths being in the Play park and causing a nuisance with noise, however this seems to have been an isolated case and no reported damage.
