1. Apologies:- Councillor Steve Knight, District Councillor Brian Phillips, and County Councillor Annabel Wilkinson.

2. Minutes of the meeting held on the 16th November 2017

The minutes of the meeting held on the 16th November 2017 were circulated, read, confirmed and signed as a true record.

3. Matters arising:- Road signs:-

Following the Councils request for the signs making motorists aware of the Play Park a further discussion suggested another solution would be to have 40mph signs further back up Mountsrall Lane in order to slow traffic approaching the village. This request was to be put to NYCC by the Clerk.

Viewley Hill :-

Following the invitation to the Deputy Manager Mr Stuart Ingham to attend the January PC meeting the Clerk received an apology from him on the 17th stating he could not attend but could we offer any solutions to the parking issues. The Clerk was asked to respond that any encouragement that could

be given to the Company to move the staff vehicles to off the road parking would be one solution.

4. Children's Play Area:- The Council listened to the report by the Parishioners who spoke from having their children use the zip wire that in their view is was not fit for purpose and was also damaged.

After some discussion it was agreed that the Clerk arrange a site visit with Streetscape and as many mothers and children as possible attend to demonstrate the issues and to seek a solution.

The 2 Parishioners then left the meeting.

5. Approval of payment of invoice from NYCC for grit bin. This was done and a cheque issued.

6. Planning Applications:- 17/02726/FUL Proposed ground floor alterations and extensions to Inglenook, Danby Wiske, DL7 0NQ, for Mrs C Robinson. After viewing the plans and discussing them the Council had no objections to the application

17/02076/FUL Change of use of ancillary domestic building to a holiday cottage at Mossa Grange, Little Langton DL7 0TL. Applicant Mr David Belerby. Now approved. No observations or objections were raised.

17/02717/FUL Pitched roofed steel framed structure over an existing slurry pit at Willow Tree Farm, Thrintoft, DL7 0QA. Applicant Mr H Pattison. No observations or objections were raised.

7. Police Report:- A Police report had been received by the Clerk on the 21st December with no reported crimes for the period prior to this.

8. Blocked Culverts on Danby Lane:- A local landowner reported that in his view the flooding of the Danby Road east of the main railway line was due to the culverts being blocked and could the Clerk report this to NYCC

9. Clerk:- The Clerk reported that due to a change of circumstances he would have to resign as Clerk with effect from the AGM in April/May and a replacement should be sought.

10. Chairman:- The Chairman Margaret Goldie stated that she wanted to stand down as Chairman for personal reasons but wished to remain a councillor. This action to take effect from the AGM also.

11. The Clerk read out several items of correspondence

Improvement to street lighting.

From Highways a report stating that the pot holes near the play area were not serious enough to warrant repairs at present.

An estimate from Walkers for the grass cutting for the forth coming season of £46 per cut with approx 14 to 16 cuts.

The Clerk stated that the bank account stood with £144.62 in uncommitted funds.
