Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Thursday 21st March 2019

1. To receive apologies

Apologies were received from Geoff Solomon and Alastair Wilkin

2. To confirm the minutes of meeting held on 21 February 2019 as a true and correct record

3.1 <u>To receive further information on the agreement for the maintenance of the defibrillator.</u>

Copies of the agreement had been received and were signed by the Chair on behalf of the Parish Council. An invoice will be presented after 1st April.

Two nominations have been received for this committee leaving one vacancy. None of the councillors present wished to be considered.

The pole was replaced in a single day and the debris removed promptly at the request of the Clerk.

3.5 To receive further details of the requests made by the Village Hall Committee. Jean Norris explained that Alan Scaife of The Arden Arms at Atley Hill had donated money for the purchase of a tree which the village hall committee seeks the Parish Council's permission to plant on the green. The chosen tree is a slow-growing spruce, Abies koreana, of maximum height 20 feet and requiring low maintenance. The councillors resolved to give

permission for the planting of the tree, with the understanding that the village hall committee would be fully responsible for its planting and maintenance. The councillors will decide on the exact location once the tree has been delivered.

With regard to the siting of the picnic bench on the green, it was resolved that it should be moveable and sited at the southern end of the green.

3.6 To receive information on the reporting of road conditions in the parish.

The Clerk reported that HDC do not consider the state of the village roads to meet the criteria necessary for repair.
